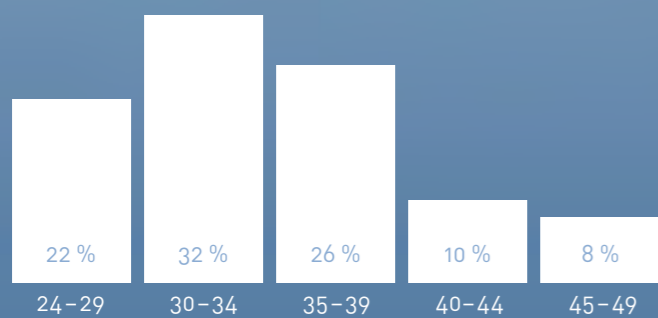

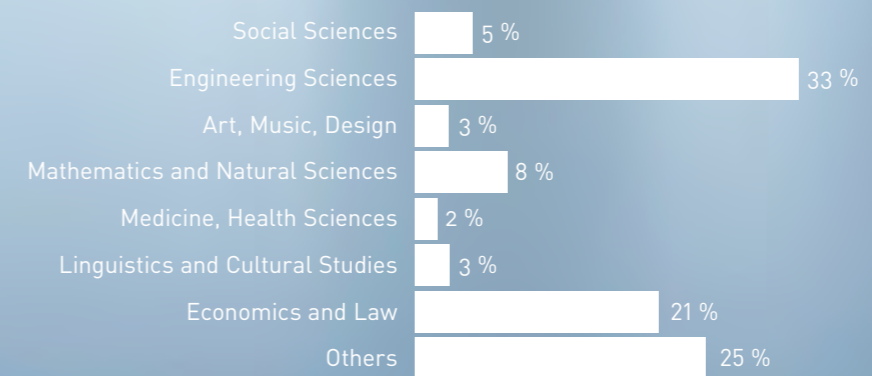

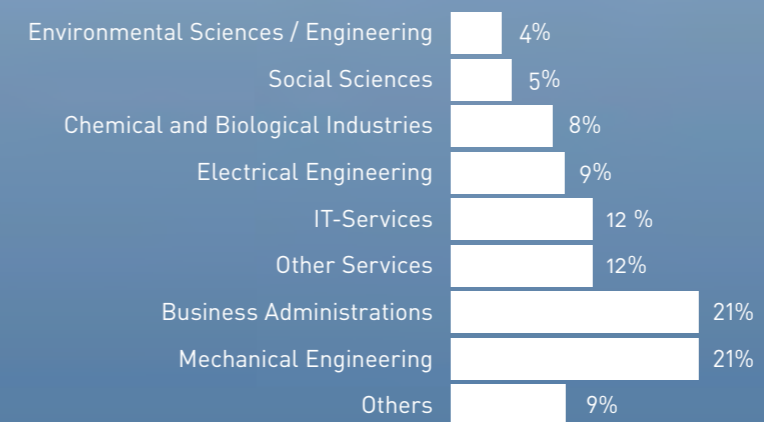

Enrolling in the MBA program is straightforward. Should you have any questions about the program or admissions process, please do not hesitate to contact us. Our dedicated staff at Darmstadt Business School is here to assist you. Upon request, we are more than happy to review your documents in advance.

Admission

Requirements

Admission to the MBA program at Darmstadt Business School requires an above-average first university degree, a minimum of three years of relevant professional experience, and proficient English language skills (TOEFL score of 88 points or IELTS score of 6.5).

Your Application

Applying to the MBA program at Darmstadt Business School is a straightforward process consisting of only a few simple steps. For more detailed information, please visit our website at: darmstadt-mba.h-da.de.

Admissions Decision

As soon as your application materials have been received by the university, they will be reviewed by the examination board, which will then make a decision regarding your admission to the MBA program.

Deadlines

For specific deadlines corresponding to the option you choose, please refer to our website at: darmstadt-mba.h-da.de.

To ensure a smooth application process, we encourage you to apply as early as possible. If you require a visa, please note that additional time may be needed. It typically takes 2-4 months after admission until you obtain your study visa.

Here We Go!

Welcome to the MBA program at Darmstadt Business School! Your journey will kick off with an orientation event – usually scheduled at the end of September.

Costs and Scholarships

Tuition fees for the MBA program at Darmstadt Business School is a fixed price including registration and exams. Even if you choose to take a semester off or need to repeat an exam, there are no additional fees. However, please note that costs for excursions are not included in the tuition.

In addition, students are required to pay a semester fee for the University of Applied Sciences Darmstadt, which includes the student ticket for public transportation in the region. For the current price of the semester fee, please visit: darmstadt-mba.h-da.de.

Alumni of the University of Applied Sciences Darmstadt enjoy a discount of 20% on the MBA program's tuition.

Darmstadt Business School offers partial MBA scholarships per year. These scholarships cover up to 40% of the total tuition fees. They are awarded to outstanding personalities who demonstrate high leadership potential in their professional and social environment.

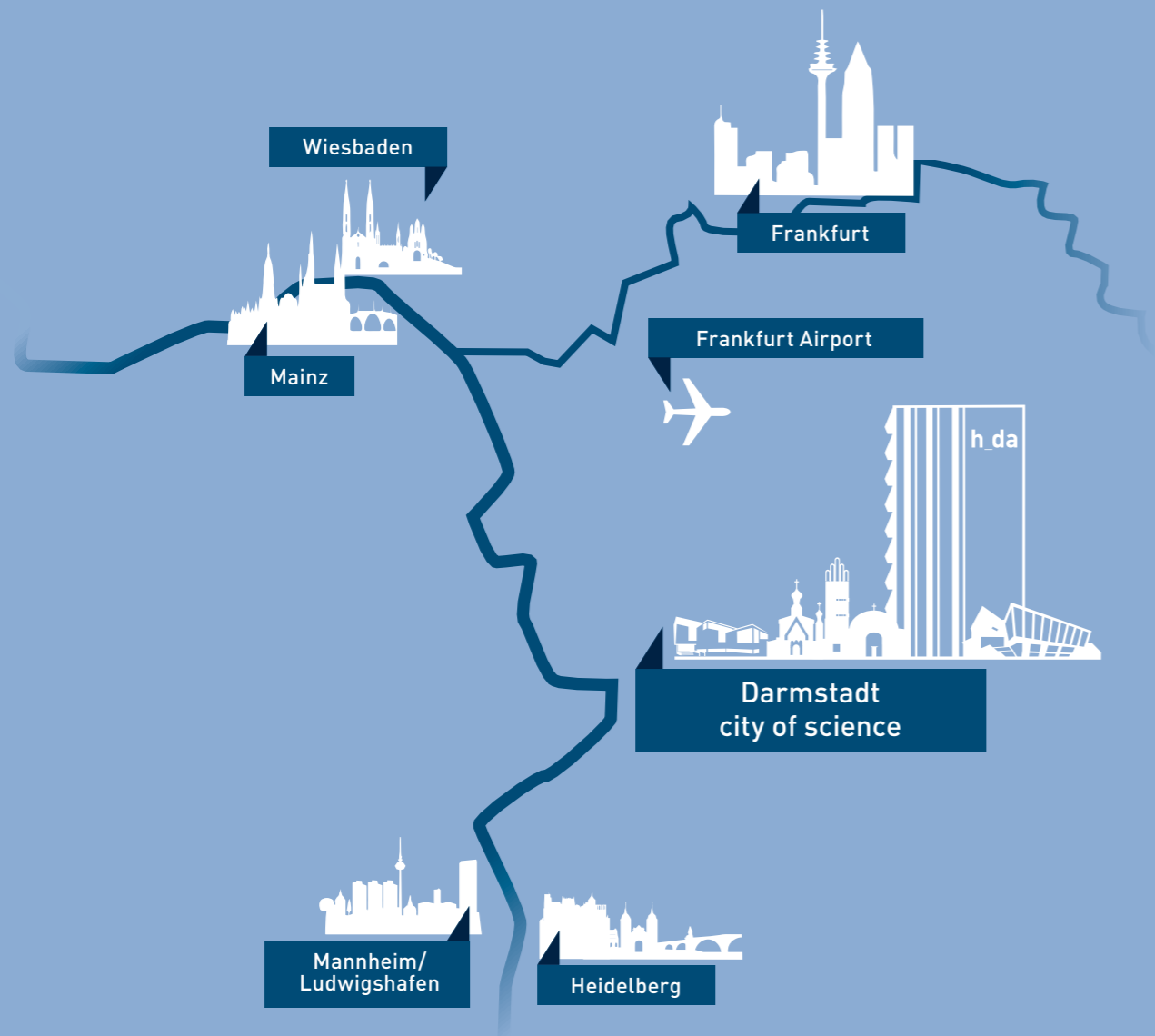
